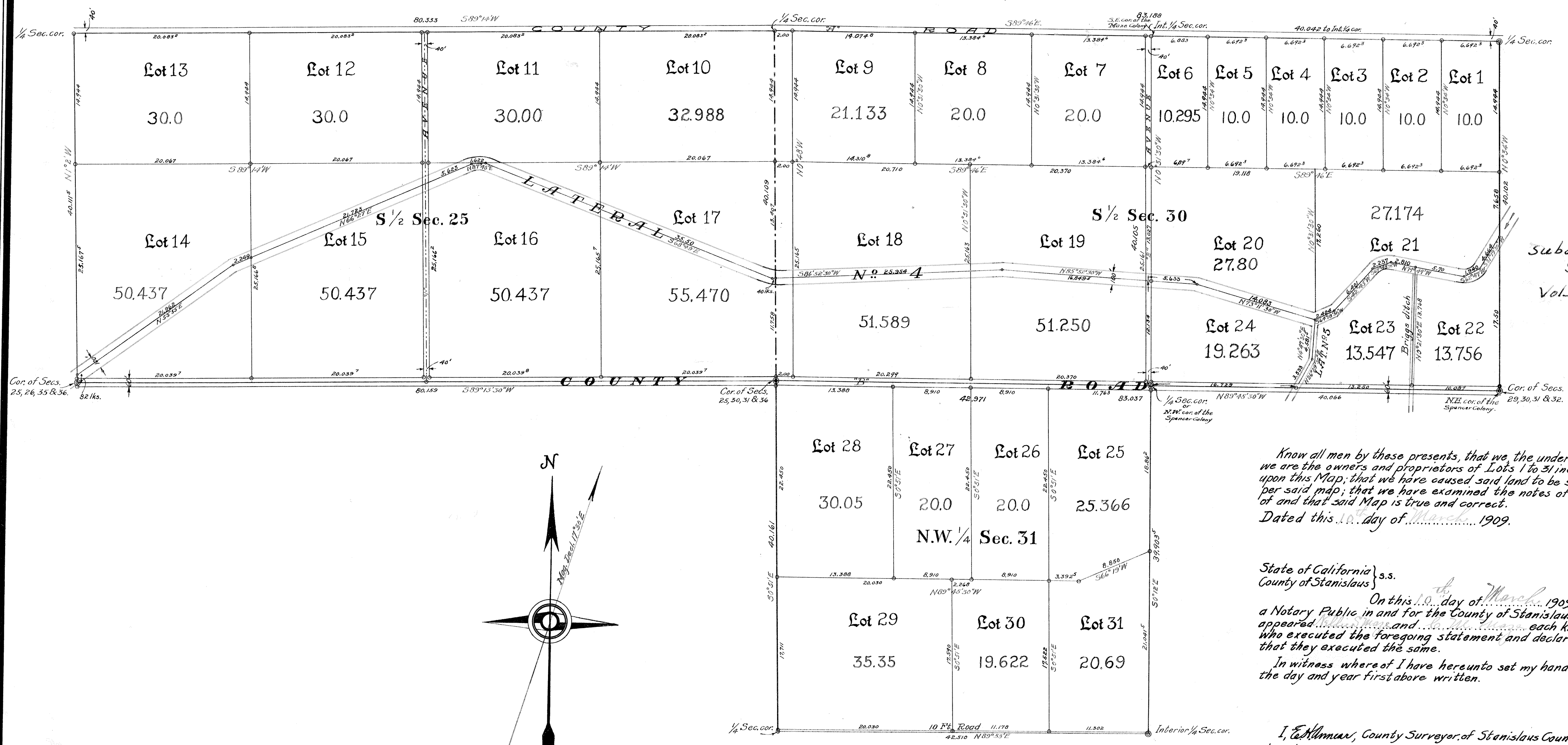


MAP OF THE MAZE RANCH SUBDIVISION
